Foreword

This Ordo aims to give simple directions for the friars of our Province – which includes Australia, New Zealand, Solomon Islands and Papua New Guinea - *in the dioceses in which we have foundations*. Friars travelling in other dioceses will still need to consult local calendars.

As well as the *General Roman Calendar* and the *Calendar* of our Order, local patrons and celebrations have been included where they are known. Also included are liturgical directives or advice, drawn from the liturgical books of the Roman Rite or our Order, and the documents of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Sacraments, including the 2002 *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*. These indications are included to draw attention to easily neglected or misunderstood provisions. They are not complete, nor do they always refer to the most important aspects of liturgy. Recourse should always be had to the original documents.

Changes for 2009

Australian readers will notice that the Episcopal Conference has designated two **ember days** to be observed as special days of prayer and penance: the first Friday in March and September. The idea of “ember days” (or “quarter tense” days, as they were sometimes called) is to mark the change of seasons with prayer for good weather, timely rain, fruitfulness of crops and the productivity of human labour. The Mass is any appropriate text from the *Masses for Various Needs and Occasions*; when the Autumn Ember day falls in Lent, the readings are from the Lectionary for that day in Lent.

On the Dominican Calendar there have been no changes this year, but several optional celebrations included in the *Additamenta* to the Proper have been noted: the *Conversion of St Augustine* (24 April), *St Catherine of Sinai* (25 November) and *St Dominic of Silos* (20 December).

The document *Guidelines for Liturgical Celebrations in the Order of Preachers* has not been reproduced this year, in order to save space. However, together with the Ordo itself, it will be found at the Province’s website: <http://www.op.org.au/cal>

INTRODUCTION

This Liturgical Calendar follows the *Roman Calendar* and the proper *Calendar of the Order of Preachers*, adapted for use in Australia, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea and Solomon Islands by the inclusion of celebrations proper to the Order and celebrations proper to those countries.

Local celebrations (titular feasts, diocesan patrons, anniversaries of dedication etc.) are shown for those places where the Province has foundations. Those working or living in other places need to consult local calendars for local variations.

I. The Calendar:

Certain celebrations [e.g., Christmas, Pentecost and Birth of John the Baptist] have proper **Vigil Masses** in addition to the Mass for the day itself. These Vigil Masses are intended to be used either before or after Evening Prayer I of the celebration. For pastoral reasons, it is permitted to use the Mass of the Day in place of the Vigil Mass (except, of course, for the Easter Vigil.)

On Saturdays in Ordinary Time when there is no obligatory memorial, an **optional memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary** is encouraged. Whenever this optional memorial is allowed, the special votive Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary proper to the Order, or a Mass from *the Collection of Masses in Honour of the Blessed Virgin Mary* may be used as an alternative. For the Office, the proper offices in the Liturgy of the Hours or the votive offices of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the *Dominican Supplement* may be used.

II. Patronal Feasts and Solemnities:

In addition to the celebrations proper to each province, a community should celebrate the following:

- Solemnity of the Anniversary of the Dedication of the church on the anniversary day of the dedication, if the church was consecrated. If the day of dedication is unknown, this solemnity is observed on Oct 22;
- Solemnity of the titular saint of the church;
- Solemnity of the principal patron of their house;
- Feast of the Anniversary of the Dedication of the cathedral;
- Feast of the principal patron of the diocese, territory, province, or more extensive territory.

III. Typography of this Calendar:

- A. *Italics*: indicate an optional celebration, e.g., Dec 4, *St John of Damascus*. They are also used for words in languages other than English, e.g. *Te Deum*.
- B. Explanatory material is set in smaller type.
- C. The letters **OP** in the margin indicate rubrical directions proper to the Order.
- D. Celebrations belonging to a particular church or place are placed in a grey box.
- E. *Blesseds on the Calendar for the Provinces (which is a supplement to the Martyrology - cf. General Instruction of the Roman Missal, n. 355) appear like this.*
- F. *Anniversaries of deceased Masters of the Order appear like this.*
- G. *Anniversaries of deceased friars of the province appear like this.*

SPECIAL INDULGENCES FOR THE ORDER

A **plenary indulgence**, under the usual conditions, may be gained by a brother who makes or renews, at least privately, his intention to fulfil faithfully the duties of his vocation:

For the whole Order:

- on the feasts of the Birth of the Lord, Easter, Annunciation, Assumption of B. V. Mary, St Dominic, St Thomas Aquinas, St Catherine of Siena and All Saints of the Order;
- on the occasion of a General Chapter.

For the individual houses:

- on the feast of the principal patron of the house;
- on the feast of saints or blessed whose body or principal relics are kept there;
- at the end of regular visitation.

For individual brothers:

- on the day of entering the novitiate
- on the day of first profession and the day of solemn profession;
- on the 25th, 50th, 60th and 75th anniversary of first profession.

GUIDELINES FOR SOLOMON ISLANDS AND PAPUA NEW GUINEA

In 2005 the bishops of Solomon Islands and Papua New Guinea published *Pastoral Guidelines for Celebrating Mass* which should be observed by friars in the Vicariate. While in general these guidelines complement and explain the common liturgical law of the Church, in some cases they make specific provisions regarding cultural practices - e.g. a *singsing* group leading the entrance or offertory processions (nn. 60 & 97) - or derogate from the common law by allowing some latitude due to climate and other local conditions - e.g. the substitution of a white cassock or habit for the alb (nn. 55 & 143). This *Ordo* should be read in conjunction with, and subject to, the *Guidelines*.

Innumerable ages having passed since the creation of the world, when in the beginning God created heaven and earth and formed mankind after his own image; many centuries after the flood, when the Most High placed his rainbow in the heavens as a sign of peace and of the covenant; twenty-one centuries after the going forth of Abraham, our father in faith, from Ur of the Chaldees; thirteen centuries from the exodus of the people of Israel out of Egypt, led by Moses; about one thousand years from the anointing of David as King; in the sixty-fifth week according to the prophecy of Daniel; in the one hundred and ninety-fourth Olympiad; in the year seven hundred and fifty-two from the founding of the city of Rome; in the forty-second year of the rule of Caesar Octavian Augustus; when the whole world was at peace: Jesus Christ, eternal God and Son of the eternal Father, being pleased to hallow the world by His most gracious coming, having been conceived of the Holy Spirit, and nine months having passed since His conception, having become Man, was born at Bethlehem in Judah of the Virgin Mary.

Here all kneel. At a sign from the prior, all rise and the reader continues:

THE NATIVITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST ACCORDING TO THE FLESH.

The reader may continue with the Martyrology for the day:

At Rome, the commemoration of Saint Anastasia, a martyr of Sirmium in Hungary.

Also at Rome, in the cemetery of Apronianus on the Latin Way, the martyr, Saint Eugenia.

Also at Rome on the Latin Way, the martyrs, Saints Basil and Jovinian.

At Cracow in Poland, Saint Adalbert Adam Chmielowski, a religious, an outstanding artist, who devoted himself to the poor, striving to assist them in all ways, and who founded Congregations of Brothers and Sisters of the Third Order of Saint Francis for the service of the poor.
